AGENDA DISCUSSED AS A WHOLE

- The Chair and Officer asked for the meeting to be brief as most points had been enacted.

- Malaika went over the previous assembly, they explained the major points raised such as:
 - Diversity of union staff
 - Having DESH foods on campus every other monthMalaika got in touch with the people in charge of the markets and is making progress on getting DESH foods on campus
Malaika and Oksana discussed the progress of the booklet and explained that it has not been sent out.

- Katharina suggested that the work of the International Committee should be publicised to attract more people to the assemblies.
- Katharina explained that the introduction of make up for darker skin tones in the shop was not well carried out as the products are hidden, of a lower quality and are not marketed well.
- Malaika and Oksana explained that International students no longer need to carry their passports to the LCR as the campus cards are equipped with the respective dates of birth and can be scanned at the door.
- There was an idea to have flyers from the Student's Union in the freshers welcome packs that ask students to sign up to the website and tick as an international.
- The committee talked about methods of increasing the reach and agreed on publicising the work, create marketing material and use cultural and regional societies.

- Malaika introduced a proposal that will be forwarded to the upcoming Union Council meeting. The motion is being seconded by Muqaddam. They explained that the core of the motion is to make the SU leadership race more understandable and open for international students. This will push students to learn about the SU, develop leadership skills and get a wholesome experience from the Union.

- Malaika is going to introduce a new motion on the diversity of staff in the union which leads to a disparity in the effort and push towards different events. The motion will encourage having more positions to cater to more demographic groups.
