1927 Flexible Leases for Postgraduate Students

Union Notes:

- 1. Many postgraduate students live on campus while studying.
- 2. Postgraduate student leases are always a full year, from September to September.
- 3. Many off-campus student leases end in June or July, meaning that campus accommodation is often in high demand over summer for students working in Norwich or researching over summer.
- 4. Postgraduate students, especially those doing development based subjects, often do their research away from Norwich.
- 5. If a postgraduate student needs to continue their studies elsewhere they must find someone to take their room themselves.

Union Believes

- 1. Postgraduate students need their leases to be more flexible, and have the ability to arrange leases that end in early summer like undergraduates' leases.
- 2. We need a system for postgraduate students to be able to find other students who want to live on campus.

Union Resolves:

- 1. Mandate officers (outgoing and elect) to work with the university accommodation service to make sure postgraduate students can have more flexible leases.
- 2. Create a dedicated space on the home run website for students that want accommodation on campus.
