Union notes:

- That some motions, especially ones that consist of several pages, can be confusing.
- 2. That it can make Union council inaccessible for those with SPLDs.
- 3. Around 10% of the population have Dyslexia, this can cause text to appear distorted and words or letters appear to move or become blurred

Union Believes:

- It isn't democratic if people are voting on motions that they don't understand.
- 2. That we need to do everything we can to make union council accessible to all.
- 3. Disabled people must be able to access all areas of society

Union Resolves:

- That the proposer should write a brief summation, of no more than 200 words, at the top of every motion, to make the motions easier to understand.
- If possible the agenda should be sent out as a word document, so that people who need extra adjustments can easily adjust it to their specific needs.
