Adoption of official International Holocaust Remembrance

Summary: Summary: To adopt the IHRA definition of Antisemitism in order to prevent and categorise against Jewish students and staff.

Council Notes

1. Antisemitism has risen by 22% year on year (2017-2018, CST) and continues to be an issue for Jewish students on campus.

- 2. Leaders of the Jewish community in the UK and worldwide have sought to create a definition of Antisemitism to be adopted by political parties and other institutions
- 3. The IHRA have created a working definition of Antisemitism¹ that has been accepted in full by all major political parties within the UK
- 4. <u>UEASU must recognise Holocaust Memorial Day and support Jewish students</u> has been adopted into policy precedent as of December 2019

Council Resolves

- 1) The Students' Union should formally adopt the IHRA definition of antisemitism on campus
 - (1) "Antisemitism is a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities."
- 2) To lobby the university to formally recognise this definition to be used in all processes in which a complaint about antisemitism on campus or towards or by a student or employee at the university has been made.

Union Resolves:

1. The Students' Union should formally adopt the IHRA definition of antisemitism on campus
