

Committee – What can we spend subs money on?

What's acceptable to spend money on?

- Subs money is paid by all members when joining your club or society, so anything you spend it on must benefit and be open to **all members**
- Snacks and soft drinks for society/club events (email unionpub@uea.ac.uk to put money behind the bar for events in BarSU)
- Items related to society/club event e.g. kit, equipment, coaching, decorations, games
- Venue hire for events and related activity e.g. photographer, photo booth
- Transport to society/club related events e.g. conferences, matches, social events
- Subsidising tickets to events or trips e.g. the price of a meal
- Affiliation fees to external companies / governing bodies
- Marketing material for your society/club – this would be great for Fresher's Fayre e.g. keyrings, magnets, business cards, poster
- Alcohol included in the price of a venue package only, where non-alcoholic drinks are also provided e.g. table wine at your club/society ball

What's not acceptable to spend money on?

- Illegal items
- Items which only benefit a select group in the club/society or committee only e.g. committee hoodies, or committee meal
- Alcohol NOT provided by a licensed venue
- Alcohol bought at a supermarket for a social
- Investment or gambling of any kind
- Donations to charity (only money from fundraising events can be donated from subs accounts)
- Items members may find offensive, inappropriate or unacceptable in nature e.g. cards against humanity
