01 General Business	<p>Welcome: Introductions and pronouns</p> <p>NA welcomes all attendees and introduces the meeting. She encourages everyone to do the same. All other attendees introduce themselves, stating their name, pronouns and role in relation to the uea(su).</p>

03	<p>General Updates and Community projects idea generation/discussion</p> <p>MPH has recently finished with Queer History Month at the end of Feb, which was successful, and has started to brainstorm for Trans Day of Visibility at the end of the month. They are hoping to chat with bar team about ways to increase engagement with Spectrum.</p> <p>JB shares the dates of Sustainability week (22nd April – 2nd May) and the activities they have planned; including a charity sports day, music festival, climate hackathon, workshops, school visits, etc. The activities will be a combination of efforts from both clubs and societies as well as local groups. JB reports that due to less students helping out than desired so they have a lower capacity but will focus on the main events. As part of the week, JB will be doing ‘Sustainability and Social Impact 101’ training which is open to anyone, but JB recommends to PTOs and FTOs.</p> <p>JB is working with Taiyo (DEV Student of Colour Ambassador), to map out spaces on campus to make into student green spaces with funding received. They were hoping to plant fruit trees. Their initial aim was to acquire a large garden area for students to own and upkeep but UEA said no and so they are doing ‘kitchen gardens’ for each accommodation that students living in that accommodation can access and harvest the fruit and vegetable from.</p> <p>JB has started booking people in for sports day and fundraisers, so she encourages people to share this with friends and others, as a chance to raise money for a charity of their choosing. JB also has a fundraiser and second-hand sales in the hive tomorrow (11th March).</p> <p>JB asks whether anyone has other updates that they would like to share.</p> <p>MPH has a changing room and bathrooms campaign ongoing with Voice and a Report and Support campaign currently awaiting reply on. MPH is planning for pride month to have a fundraiser event for local Trans charities such as Queer Norfolk, in collaboration with Pride Society. MPH also shares that he is working on the Gender Expression fund.</p> <p>JB suggests requesting funding via Executive Committee as they may be able to help.</p> <p>NY asks if Spectrum is going to continue and asks for updates. MPH states that he is unsure if Spectrum is occurring again and offers to spread awareness if it is happening again.</p> <p>NA suggests contacting and collaborating with the Afro-Caribbean Queer Society to which MPH confirms that they are in touch with ACQS and have plans to continue working with them. NA’s housemate is on committee and so she has offered to pass on the message.</p>
