003 General Discussion

BP asks for updates from each convenor, as the meeting is not quorate.

VS shares concerns about the UEA50 random selection system.

TN has nothing to raise.

AJ raises that she has put on a bake sale in collaboration with PSYSOC raising £500 for a student that passed away, and that they have raised over £3000 in total.

MF reports no major updates, but that a first year has left so they're looking for a replacement.

BMJ notes that she is getting know people from the seven schools in SSF and that she has attended a faculty meeting and met the heads of schools.

TL notes that BBS has resigned and so she is acting as the PG lead for now, and that she can be contacted for PGT or PGR concerns. She also notes that she has completed the academic rep review, and that this has been shared with Becky Price and Simon Lancaster, and that the review is going to UEA50 this February.

TL notes that she is also reviewing the advisory system and found that ECO scored very low for advisor satisfaction, with a 48% satisfaction rate so she is prioritising that now and is taking examples from NBS.

TL notes also that she has raised the module cuts issue at council to see if there is a way to embed to employability modules as an alternative.

UC notes that the academic year has just begun, so he has no updates.

Question: TL asks faculty convenors how FLTQCs are going.

Answer: UC states that he's been to one last term. BMJ states that she has been to an FLTQC and has met a few of the school convenors in the school.

AHS notes that she will be attending FLTQCs from now on, and asks faculty convenors if they'd like a pre-meet with her before, and will be in communication with them during the meeting.

UC notes that this will be a nice addition.

BP reminds convenors that they can run in the current elections if they are interested in a role.

TL asks if convenors could find out a bit about how students feel about their advisors.
