01 General Business

04 Officer Updates

TL (UG Officer)

TL runs through updates, including improvements to the advisor system, the new academic rep remuneration system, and planning the TEAs awards ceremony.

CM notes that they are running a soup kitchen, and that they have been in a meeting with TL (UG Officer) and AD about supporting trans students. CM notes that there is also a night market happening in March to raise money for the Matthew Project.

MH

MH updates that they have been working on the queer history month conference through this weekend and invites the committee to join. MH also notes that they were in the meeting about supporting trans students and is collaborating with PrideSoc. MH notes that they are working on the sports night changing room guidance as well.

SN

SN notes that they are planning a rough sleeping event to raise money for the homelessness charities in Norwich.

BJ

BJ notes that they are currently working on a holi event that is coming up in collaboration with other convenors and PG committee

TL (Students with Disabilities Officer)

TL notes that they are organising the UEA Accessibility Awards and have been supporting the disabled students' community in planning events. They are also working

on accessible accommodation by meeting with local companies and reaching out to different people and the uni.

CT

CT notes that they have been helping a PhD student recruit over 65s to take part in a survey and that they are starting a peer support group for families of alcoholics.

SA

SA notes that they are creating a report and creating a consultation project for January intake students, as well as working with INTO on affordable accommodation options.

JB

JB notes that they have been working on sustainability week, sports day, and the market and showcase, alongside club and soc events. £4,000 has been raised so far, and the next fundraiser has been launched. Next week there is a second-hand sales market in the Hive. The week after there will be a too good to go sale.

AT has organised another POC social in collaboration with MH. Art exhibition is still being planned, and they have been planning some ethics with AK with regards to research on how being a woman of colour affects your education, as well as how negative media can affect mental health. AT notes that they have been working with AD to update the Go Global page on website

AK notes that they have done a campaign for sexual abuse and sexual violence in collaboration with clubs and they have spread awareness. AK also notes that they will start organising womens history month, and asks those interested to message them if they would like to be added to the group.
